CEMETERY SUNDAY 2019 - 11 AUGUST

The annual *Service of Blessing* will take place on Sunday 11 August at 3.00pm in Holy Cross Cemetery, Sheetland Road and at 4.00pm in Old Cemetery, Termonfeckin.

FAMILIES ARE ASKED TO BRING ALONG THEIR OWN HOLY WATER TO BLESS THEIR GRAVES ON THE DAY.

In order to ensure everyone's safety and to help us follow current traffic Regulations. An Garda Síochána have asked all attending to abide by the following:

3:00PM PRAYER SERVICE AT HOLY CROSS CEMETERY

1. Park in the field close to the cemetery which on the day is reserved for the majority of cars and walk over to the Cemetery. The Gardai have said that cars are not to be parked along the Sheetland Road.
2. Parking in the grounds of Holy Cross Cemetery is only for people who are too ill or frail to walk.



Stewards wearing orange vests will be in attendance at Holy Cross Cemetery and inside the field close by for parking to help keep pedestrians safe, and traffic flowing - please follow their directions.

4:00PM PRAYER SERVICE AT OLD CEMETERY

Park in the church grounds, Parochial House car park, the Credit Union car park, or any other space where permission has been given by the owner. The Gardai have said that cars are not to be parked in contravention to parking regulations.

2. Parking in the Cemetery driveway is only for people who are too ill or frail to walk.

Stewards wearing orange vests will be in attendance at the entrance to Old Cemetery driveway to help keep pedestrians safe and traffic flowing - please follow their directions.

A Collection will once again take place outside both cemeteries on the day to help maintain these sacred places.
