Remember if you use a BTE hearing aid then you can improve your hearing experience with the 'T' position on your hearing aid.

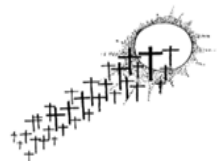


## EUCCHARISTIC ADORATION
