AUXILIARY BISHOP MICHAEL ROUTER'S STATEMENT ON CLOGHERHEAD SHOOTING

"I want to, on behalf of all the people and priests of the Archdiocese of Armagh, condemn in the strongest possible terms the callous murder last Tuesday week of Keith Branigan in the Ashling Holiday Park in Clogherhead, Co Louth, and to offer our condolences to his wife Rachel and to their loved ones. Such violence and disregard for life is always appalling but for such an act to take place in a holiday camp where people were enjoying the last days of summer, and near to where children were playing, is truly shocking. Such a cycle of violence will only lead to further tragedy and loss of life so I would appeal for those involved to desist and consider the futility of their actions. I would ask anyone who has any information on this murder or other acts associated with the feud to bring that information to the Gardaí. All of us have an obligation as well to pray that there may be peace and harmony in communities throughout this island and for a renewal of respect for human life which has been so weakened in our society in recent years."
