Today (Sunday 12 November) the Rosary will be recited in Holy Cross Cemetery followed on Sunday 19 November in the Old Cemetery .

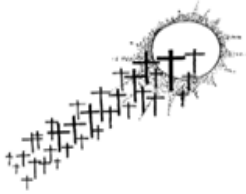
*Come, join us as we reverently pray for our families & neighbours. May they rest in peace.*
