Today (Sunday 5 November) the Rosary will be recited in the Old Cemetery followed on Sunday 12 November in Holy Cross Cemetery.

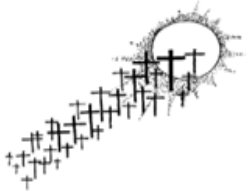


Come, join us as we reverently pray for our families & neighbours. May they rest in peace.
