



#### ST ELIZABETHS CONVENT, MINSK

Next weekend 2/3 March we welcome the sisters from St Elizabeth's Convent in Minsk, who will have a small craft stall selling items that have been made by them and those they support in their convent, which was founded in 1999 on the outskirts of Minsk. The convent currently has just under 100 nuns and around 300 sisters of mercy. They provide spiritual and social help to the sick and the suffering. Since its establishment the convent has been patronizing 200 orphanage children with psychophysical deficiencies. There is a charity shelter for people who have suffer from the rough and tumble of life (the homeless, drug or alcohol addicts, ex-prisoners and the less able). Over 200 residents live there today. To aid and develop the above ministries, the nuns would greatly appreciate your support.

#### TROCAIRE LENT CAMPAIGN

Travelling so far for water each day affects other parts of the lives of Malita and her children, Margaret, Patrick and Patricia. Carrying 20 litres of water leaves the children tired and some days they are not able to go to school. Farming is an important part of how the family support themselves, but a lack of water makes farming difficult. #### **ZAMBIA UPDATE**

Two items of update re our Zambia outreach. In summer 2023 a generous donor contributed €5000 to our Zambia fund which was given to the hospice in St. Mary's parish. After consideration the hospice used the donation to buy a blood count machine. This is an essential piece of equipment for the clinic which for the most parts treats patients who are HIV+ and where blood tests are required frequently. The nearest hospital is several hours away and the people are unable to travel the long distance in order to both have the tests and receive results and treatment. Secondly, Zambia has come to the end of its rainy season. It was a mixed bag of heavy downpours and dry spells which isn't good for the crops. Unfortunately this past two weeks has seen unseasonably hot weather - 10 degrees Celsius above normal and the highest ever recorded for this time of year. It has dried the ground too quickly and has damaged the young crops with significant stock losses already. This will cause severe shortage of maize meal which is the people's main food and therefore cause the retail prices to soar in the coming months. Please continue to keep them all in your prayers.
