Charity Tax Relief Scheme Do you contribute €250 or more to your parish in any one year? Are you self employed or a PAYE taxpayer? If you do and you pay tax you are eligible to participate in the Charity Tax Relief Scheme, this will cost you nothing but is of great benefit to the parish. For every €250 donated, the parish can claim back €112.32 from revenue.

All you have to do is complete a CHY3 cert which is available on line at www.revenue.ie or from Ann/Rosey in the parish office and return it on the plate at any mass or post it to the Parochial House at your convenience. If you completed a CHY3 form back in 2020 it's now time to complete another one please (they are only valid for 5 year's, if you can't remember call Ann/Mary in the office and they will help you).
