Today we pray and thank God for the new Saints Carlo Acutis and Pier Giorgio Frassati, canonised on Sunday 7th September Canonisation is the Church's declaration that a person is in heaven, enjoying the Beatific Vision. It does not mean the Church "makes" saints; rather, it confirms their heroic holiness. The pope, guided by the Holy Spirit, speaks infallibly for the whole Church, placing the person's name in the canon of saints. Once canonised, a saint may be publicly venerated: invoked in prayers, honoured with dedicated churches or

altars, remembered at Mass and the Divine Office, and given a feast day or patronage. The declaration is made by the pope during a solemn Mass known as the Rite of Canonisation.
